Learning with Young Leaders

For five weeks, Young Leaders connected, investigated, explored and thought critically about what it means to tend a garden in a city.



In their gardens, they tested soil, tried their hand at hydroponic growing, and learned how to make a simple, natural spray to repel those pesky produce-eating insects and pests. They took excellent care of their gardens throughout their 5 week program - weeding, watering, and harvesting a variety of produce including garlic, tomatoes, carrots, greens, and herbs!

Groups also went beyond the garden with field trips to local grocery stores in order to investigate issues of food access; to the Charles River Floating Wetland to learn about efforts to clean and beautify the local environment; and to The Rose Kennedy Greenway to explore their vegetable gardens and bring ideas back home to their school gardens.
